BRYAN E. BLEDSOE, DO, FACEP - Dr. Bledsoe is a Clinical Professor of Emergency Medicine at the University of Nevada School of Medicine in Las Vegas and an attending physician in the Emergency Department and Level I Trauma Center at University Medical Center in Las Vegas, Nevada.

HECTOR SALCEDO-DOVI, M.D., FACS - Board Certified Surgeon Trauma/Critical Care. Dr. Salcedo-Dovi has certifications from PALS, ACLS, ATLS. He is active as a General Surgeon, Pediatric Surgeon, Trauma Surgeon, Acute Care. He co-wrote an article in the Journal of Emergency Medicine, July 2006, Vol 31 Issue 1, Pages 33-35, Airway in Spinal Canal Associated with Trauma.

NORMA JEAN FARLEY, M.D. - Dr. Farley is Hidalgo County's Chief Forensic Pathologist. Her office was recently the location for filming of an episode of Dr. G: Medical Examiner "Deadly Remedies" for the Discovery Channel.

PAUL PEPE, MD - Dr. Pepe is the Professor of Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, Public Health & Riggs Family (endowed) Chair in Emergency Medicine (EM) at UT Southwestern, heads an academic EM program of about 55 faculty and 70 residents/fellows based at the county emergency-trauma center, Parkland Hospital. He served as the Chief Medical Officer and Vice President of Medical Affairs for Piedmont Newnan Hospital and the Medical Director for the Austin/Travis County Emergency Medical Services System.

SHAWN SALTER, RN, NREMT-P - Shawn Salter is the President & CEO of San Antonio AirLIFE and has been with the organization as Director of Clinical Operations, Chief Flight Nurse, and Flight Paramedic since March of 2000. Shawn served as the Region IV Director of the Association of Air Medical Services (AAMS).

WILLIAM SMOCK, MD, MS, FACEP, FAAEM - Dr. Smock is the Police Surgeon for the Louisville Metro Police Department. He graduated from Centre College in Danville, Kentucky in 1981 and then obtained a Master's degree in Anatomy from the University of Louisville. Bill graduated from the University of Louisville School of Medicine in 1990 and completed a residency in Emergency Medicine at the University of Louisville in 1993. Bill joined the University of Louisville's Emergency Medicine faculty in 1994 and was promoted to the rank of full professor in 2005. He is currently a Clinical Professor of Emergency Medicine at the University of Louisville School of Medicine.

JANE WIGGINTON, MD - Dr. Wigginton attended the University of Texas Southwestern Medical School in Dallas, Texas and then completed her Emergency Medicine residency at the affiliated Parkland Health & Hospital System.
